Instructions for the 2022-2023 Academic Year Recipient Must Meet and Adhere to the Following Criteria's

- 1. Applications are being accepted from March 1st to May 31st.
- 2. Application is open to all male and female senior high school students pursing an undergraduate degree or professional trade certificate that are a resident of Lynwood. COPY OF PROOF OF RESIDENCY REQUIRED IN THE FORM OF A GOVERNMENT ISSUED IDENTIFICATION CARD
- 3. Must possess a minimum overall grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale. An official transcript from the high school you are currently attending must be submitted. The envelope must be sealed with the school's official stamp across the flap. **NO EXCEPTIONS**

- 4. Must show proof of acceptance to the accredited institution you will be attending. The institution must be an accredited two (2) or four (4) year institution. (Proof of enrollment must be submitted before funds are released.)
- 5. Must be participating or have participated in at least **one (1)** extracurricular, civic, or community activity within the last year and provide **three (3)** letters of recommendation. These ferrets must be from a high school advisory counselor, current/past high school teacher, minister, organization/club, employment manager, or coach describing applicant's activities, character, and potential.
- 6. A five hundred (500) word, double spaced typed essay, in his or her own word, must accompany the application. The essay must state your future goals and explain how you believe a college/professional trade education will help you achieve your goals. (MAXIMUM 500 WORDS MINIMUM 400 WORDS)
- 7. The application must be completed in full and signed by the applicant and parent/guardian.

EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE DONATIONS WILL BE AWARDED BASED ON AVAILABLE FUNDS. THE FINAL DECISION ON THE AMOUNT AND NUMBER OF AWARDS PRESENTED WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE. ALL EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHPS RECIPIENTS WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT LYNWOOD FEST, AUGUST 13, 2023.
