The Village of Lynwood Police Department is currently seeking Illinois State CERTIFIED Part-time Officers.

Hiring Standards:

Any person employed as a part-time police officer must meet the following standards:

1. Be of good moral character, of temperate habits, of sound health, and physically and mentally able to perform assigned duties.
2. Be at least 21 years of age.
3. Pass the polygraph, medical and psychological examinations.
4. Possess a high school diploma or GED certificate.
5. Possess a valid State of Illinois driver's license.
6. Possess no prior felony convictions.
7. Any individual who has served in the U.S. military must have been honorably discharged.
8. Must be Illinois State Certified

Part-time Police Officers shall be trained in accordance with the Illinois Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705/1 et seq.), the Intergovernmental Law Enforcement Officer's In-Service Training Act (50 ILCS 720/1 et seq.) and in accordance with the procedures for part-time police officers established by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board. In accordance with Public Act 89-170, all part-time police officers in the state of Illinois are required to successfully complete a Basic Part-Time Law Enforcement Officer Training Course. The basic course consists of 400 hours of training, similar to the full-time officer course. The part-time officer must also successfully complete the Mandatory 40 hours Firearms Course and possess a valid FOID card. Part-time officers must successfully complete a field training program.
